EYFS Stay and Play takes place Friday. This will be the third and last session.

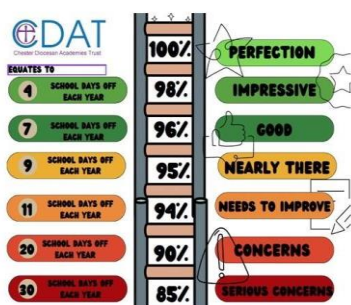
Reception parents will come into school at 9.00am with their child and leave at 10am.
