Sports Day- Spectators

The children are all very excited for Sports Day on Friday! Please remember that children are to arrive at school wearing their Sports Day coloured t-shirt, shorts and appropriate footwear. They will also need to arrive with a drink (water) and hat. Please apply sunscreen before school.

KS1 (Reception and Infant Classes)

- Please drop off your child at normal time in the morning (8.45am).
- Parents need to have vacated the playground by 9am and gates will be locked (just like a normal school day). This is to safeguard the children and allow staff to set up.
- Parents will be able to enter the school grounds via the side gate (alongside the staff car park) onto the school playground at **9.45am** and will be directed to the parent spectator area on the field. The children will be sat (in teams) on the opposite side of the track (under the gazebos). **Please do not cross the track to the children.** Remember to bring your camping chair.
- At the end of KS1 Sports Day, the teams will gather at the top of the track to be congratulated for their efforts and announce the winning team before returning to class.
- All parents will then need to leave the school grounds ahead of our normal school lunch time and set up for KS2 Sports Day.**

KS2 (Junior Classes).

- Parents will be able to enter the school grounds via the side gate (alongside the staff car park) onto the school playground at 1.15pm and will be directed to the parent spectator area on the field. The children will be sat (in teams) on the opposite side of the track (under the gazebos). **Please do not cross the track to the children.** Remember to bring your camping chair.
 - At the end of KS2 Sports Day, the teams will gather at the top of the track to be congratulated for their efforts and the winning team announced.
 - All children will then return to class.** If Sports Day finishes before the end of the normal school day (3.20pm), parents will be able to collect their child/children early from their usual pick-up point on the school playground. All other children will stay in class until the end of the normal school day.
- Friends of St Bert's will be selling drinks and crisps after school on Friday.
