

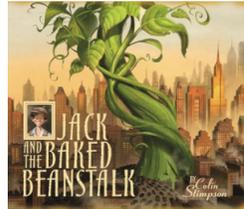


These are the main areas of learning and not the total of what will be covered.

Dear Parents/Carers

This half term we will be learning the following:

- **English:** Our chosen book for this half term will be: "Jack and the Baked Beanstalk" by Collin Stimpson. We will be writing a persuasive letter. Reading, spellings, punctuation and grammar will take place alongside this.
- **Maths:**
Year 1: Subtraction within 20, Number and place value - Numbers to 50, length and height, weight and volume.
Year 2: Multiplication and division, statistics, length and height, properties of shapes and Fractions.
- **RE: Holy Week. Easter:** How do Symbols help us understand the Easter story?
- **Geography:** Would you prefer to live in a hot or cold place?
- **Science:** Everyday Materials
- **DT:** Cooking and Nutrition -Smoothies



Items that your child needs to have in school:
