Please can you help...

Ensure that your child's (white & named) P.E kit is always in school. Both classes have P.E each week. Your child will also need trainers for outdoor PE.

Please check your child's pencil case and make sure it is restocked and labelled with your child's name on.

-2 fountain pens and spare blue ink cartridges every day (ready for when they move onto pen). – *Once your child is writing in pen you will need to check in with them regularly throughout half term as pens often break and their ink cartridges will run low quite quickly!*

Encourage your child to read daily. Please ensure that your child's reading diary is kept in their bag and in school on a daily basis. We actively work in this book during our shared reading sessions.

Weekly spelling tests will take place on a Tuesday. In addition to words being sent home each week, half termly spelling lists are also published on Google Classroom and will be given out at the start of each half term.

Homework is given out on a Monday and handed back in the following Monday. This means that your child has a whole week to complete their homework with your support.
