Phonics

This week we have continued the RWI program (Read, Write, Inc) in our new groups. We are so impressed by every child and how hard they are trying in their phonics sessions.

Our Adventures

This week, the children have been recapping castles and remembering our trip to Whittington Castle. We also learned about Remembrance Day and created beautiful poppy paintings. In My Happy Mind, we explored our superpowers and made our own superhero masks. We even joined in the fun of celebrating Children in Need! This week in maths, the children have been exploring more, less, and equal. They also got creative by making colourful pictures using only squares and rectangles.



Literacy

This week in literacy, the children were excited to return from PE to find a mysterious letter from PC Panda, explaining that someone or something had been on our school yard! The children investigated and discovered animal prints, sticks and straw, and even a blown over table. Their curiosity led to the discovery that it was the wolf from the story The Three Little Pigs! Inspired by this, our learning has focused on this classic tale. The children enjoyed creating their own pigs using paint and coloured paper, and they practiced writing CVC words to describe them, developing both their creativity and early writing skills.
