When is it Bullying?

Bullying is any behaviour that makes someone feel upset uncomfortable or frightened several times on purpose.

What should you do if you are being bullied?

DO

- ✓ If you can, ask them to stop
- ✓ Tell someone what is happening
- ✓ Most importantly – talk to someone you trust and tell them about what is happening

DON'T

- ✗ Keep it to yourself – people can't help you if they don't know about it
- ✗ Retaliate – don't get angry/upset or hit out at them
- ✗ Don't do what they say
- ✗ Don't take it personally – it is not your fault and you are not alone

What should I do?

What should you do if you see someone else being bullied?

**Don't ignore it –
TAKE ACTION!**

If safe to do so, tell the bully to STOP!
Otherwise, tell an adult straightaway.
