Book of the week: **The Train Ride & Post card from Paddington in London**

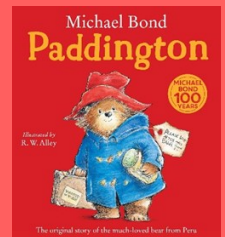
Rhyme of the week: **Row, Row, row your boat & Wheels on the Bus**
