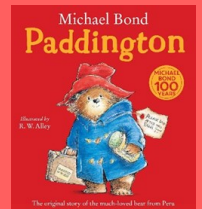
Rhyme of the week: **Five little monkeys jumping on the bed & London Bridge is Falling Down**
