## Dear Families,

We want to keep you informed about a significant change in how Ofsted reports on schools. The previous system of giving schools a single-word grade such as Outstanding or Good has now been replaced with a new approach designed to give families a clearer and more balanced picture.

## What's Changing?

- No more overall grade: Instead of one judgement, schools will receive a report card showing gradings across several key areas.
- Areas to be inspected
  - 1. Leadership and governance
  - 2. Curriculum and teaching
  - 3. Attendance and behaviour
  - 4. Achievement
  - 5. Personal development and wellbeing
  - 6. Inclusion
  - 7. Early years
- Safeguarding will continue to be judged separately as Met or Not Met.

## **New Grading Scale**

Each area will be rated on a five-point scale:

- Exceptional Among the very best nationally
- Strong Standard Excellent, consistent practice across the school
- Expected Standard Meeting all requirements children receiving everything they need
- Needs Attention Some additional work needed or the work is positive, but it needs time to embed
- Urgent Improvement Significant concerns requiring immediate action

The report card will also include a short narrative in each area and contextual information about our school.

Ofsted have shared that the 'Expected Standard' is a high bar and it will be the starting point for inspectors in each school

## Why This Matters

This new system moves away from "one label fits all" and intends to provide a more detailed picture of what schools do well and where they can improve. It is designed to be fairer and more informative for families.
