




HOW TO CONTACT US

- PARENT\€ARERS'EVENINGS.




YOUR CHILD NEEDS TO BRING THESE THINGS TO SCHOOL EVERY DAY:

- SUN HAT & SUN CREAM IF IT'S HOT.






OUR SCHOOL DAY

- 3:00-3:15 DEAR (READING) OR ASSEMBLY




CURRICULUM

- MATHS, BASED AROUND 'WHITE ROSE MATHS' SCHEME. AUTUMN: PLACE VALUE WITHIN 10, ADDITION AND SUBTRACTION WITHIN 10, GEOMETRY SHAPE WORK.
- SCIENCE, ENQUIRY AND INVESTIGATION WORK ALONGSIDE BUILDING SUBJECT KNOWLEDGE. AUTUMN: PLANTS AND SEASONAL CHANGES.



PHONICS


- SCHEME CALLED LITTLE WANDLE.
- PROGRESSES FROM RECEPTION TEACHING.
- THERE WILL BE A PHONICS ASSEMBLY LATER ON THIS TERM.
- IT IS LEARNING TO READ WORDS BUILDING ON THE PHONETIC (SOUND) MAKE-UP.
- ACCOMPANYING BOOKS TO GO WITH IT, READ IN SCHOOL AND THEN SENT HOME.
- LATER IN THE YEAR THERE IS THE NATIONAL PHONICS SCREENING CHECK.



CURRICULUM


THE SUBJECTS THAT WE COVER DURING OUR AFTERNOON TEACHING LESSONS INCLUDE:

ASSESSMENT


- PHONICS Y1 JUNE
- THE CHILDREN ALL COMPLETE THE NATIONAL PHONICS SCREENING CHECK.
- THEY READ REAL WORDS AND 'ALIEN' WORDS, USING THEIR PHONICS KNOWLEDGE FROM PHONICS SESSIONS.
- ONGOING IN OTHER LESSONS THROUGHOUT THE YEAR, AT THE END OF EACH BLOCK OF WORK.
- IDENTIFIES ANY GAPS IN KNOWLEDGE THAT WILL NEED TO BE REVISED.



HOME LEARNING

<u>READING</u>

- REALLY IMPORTANT TO READ EVERYDAY.
- USE PHONICS TO SOUND OUT THE WORDS AND TALK ABOUT WHAT IS GOING ON IN THE BOOK.
- THE BOOKS SENT HOME ARE LINKED TO THEIR PHONIC PHASE.
- RECORD READING IN THEIR READING DIARIES.
- THE BIG CAT COLLINS BOOKS ARE CLOSELY MATCHED TO THEIR PHONICS READING ABILITY. IT MUST COME BACK ON A MONDAY.
- SOMETIMES, SUPPLEMENTARY MATHS, HANDWRITING OR PHONICS REVISION MAY COME HOME WITH THE CHILDREN.

READ ANYTHING!



USE MATHS: COOK, LOOK FOR PATTERNS, SHOPPING, SET A TIMER TO RECORD,
ETC.

SCIENCE: NOTICE THE WORLD, POINT OUT CLOUDS, WEATHER PATTERNS, PLANTS AND SEEDS, ETC.

GEOGRAPHY, NOTICE WHERE THEY LIVE, SHOPS, PARK, DIFFERENT HOUSES, BUILDINGS, ETC.

HISTORY, DISCUSS WHAT YOU USED TO DO WHEN YOU WERE YOUNGER, AND HOW THINGS HAVE CHANGED.
