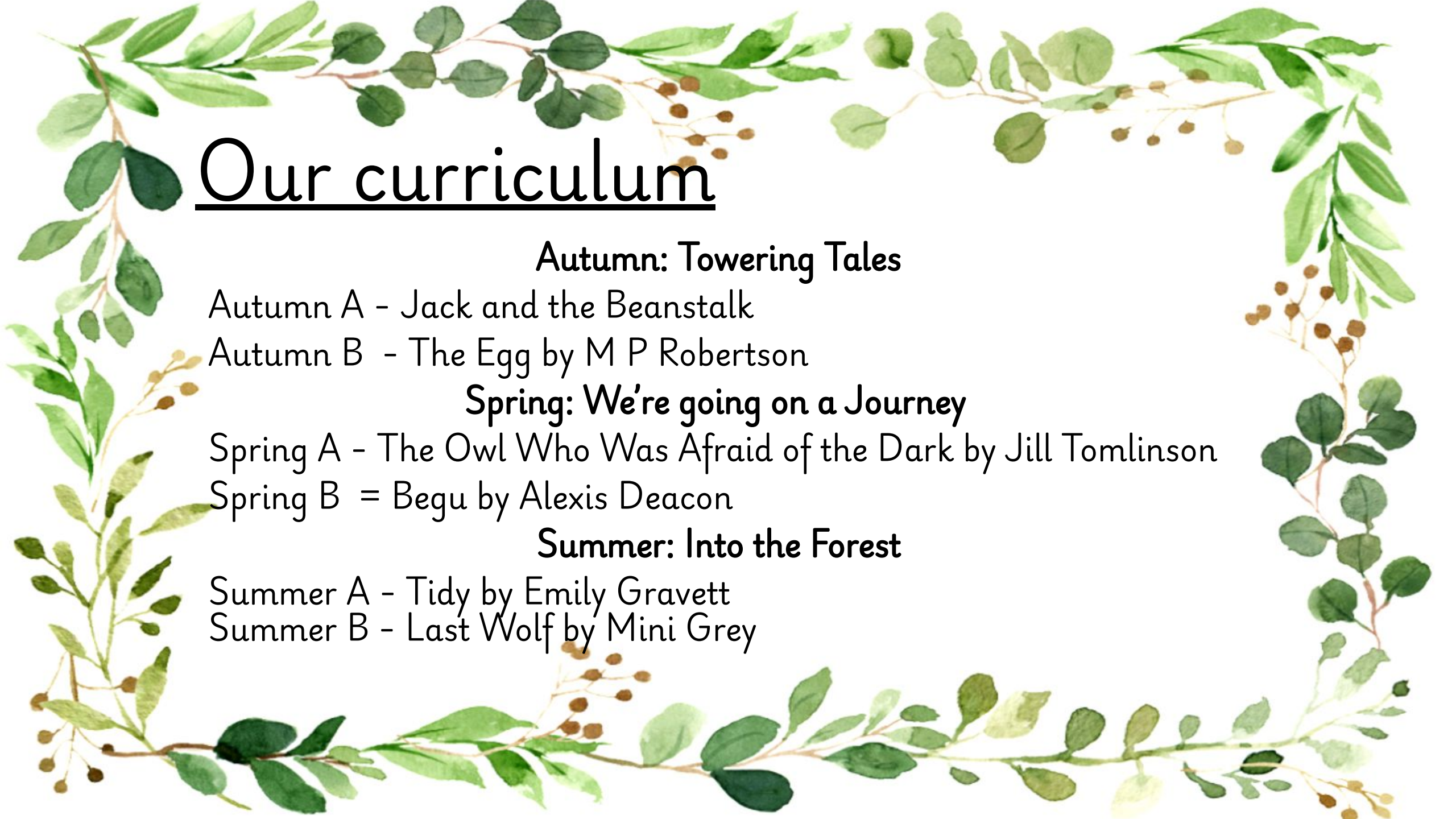

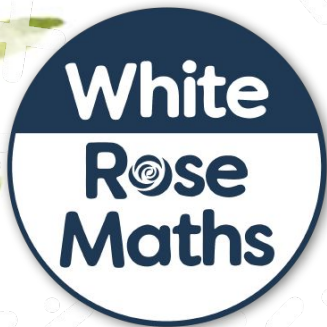

## Daily lessons

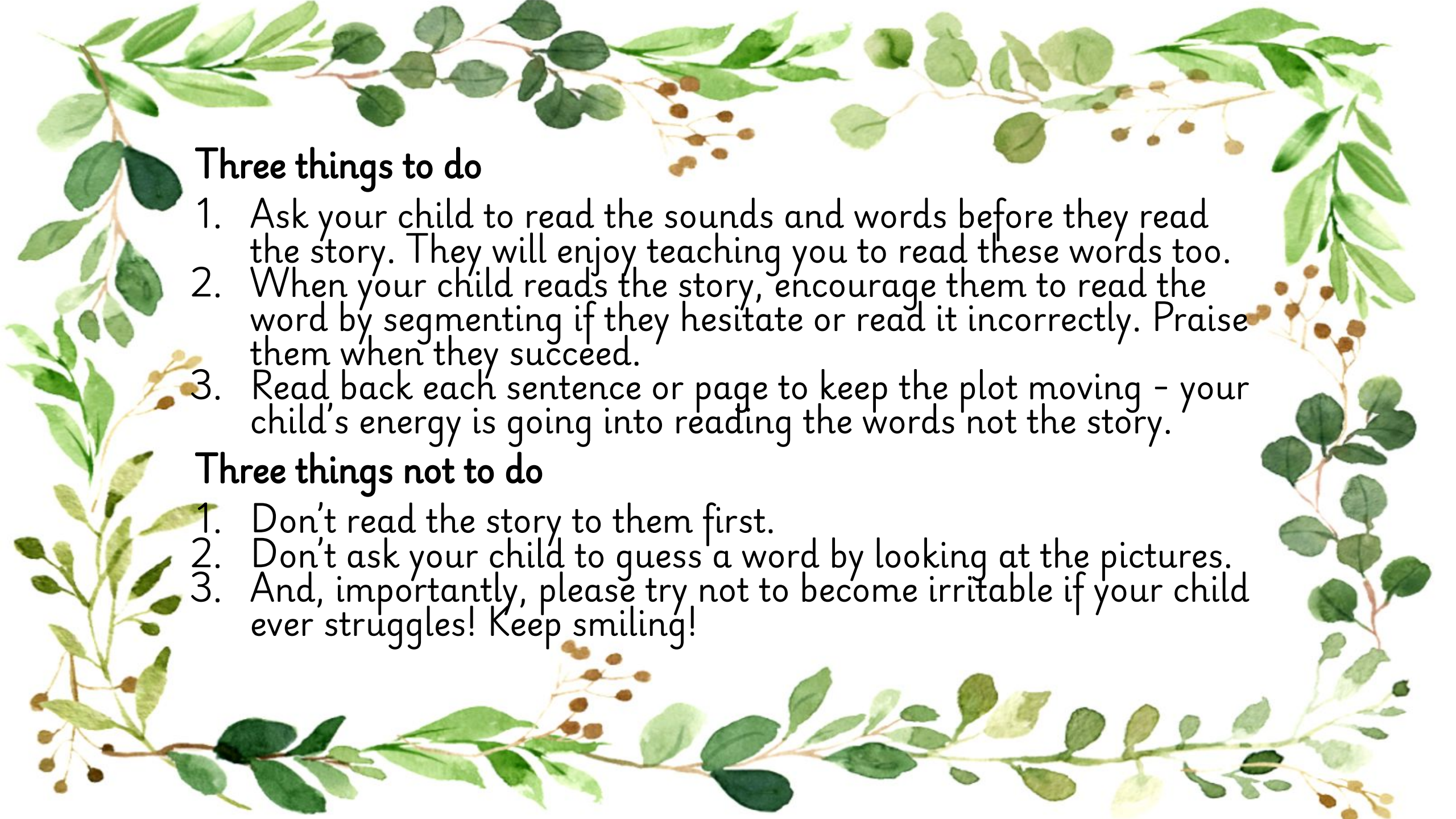

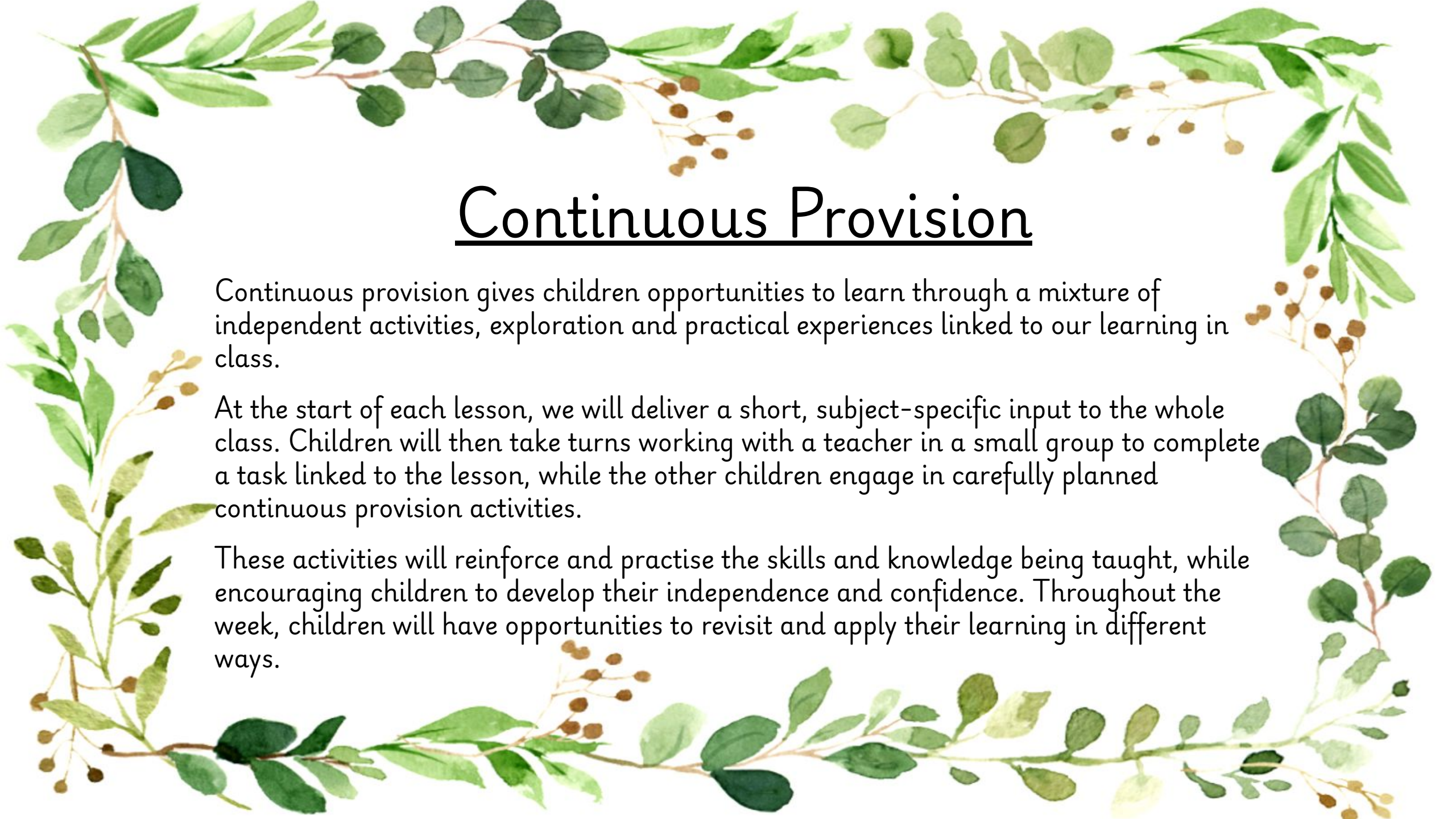


### Three things to do

1. Ask your child to read the sounds and words before they read the story. They will enjoy teaching you to read these words too.
2. When your child reads the story, encourage them to read the word by segmenting if they hesitate or read it incorrectly. Praise them when they succeed.
3. Read back each sentence or page to keep the plot moving - your child's energy is going into reading the words not the story.

### Three things not to do

1. Don't read the story to them first.
2. Don't ask your child to guess a word by looking at the pictures.
3. And, importantly, please try not to become irritable if your child ever struggles! Keep smiling!

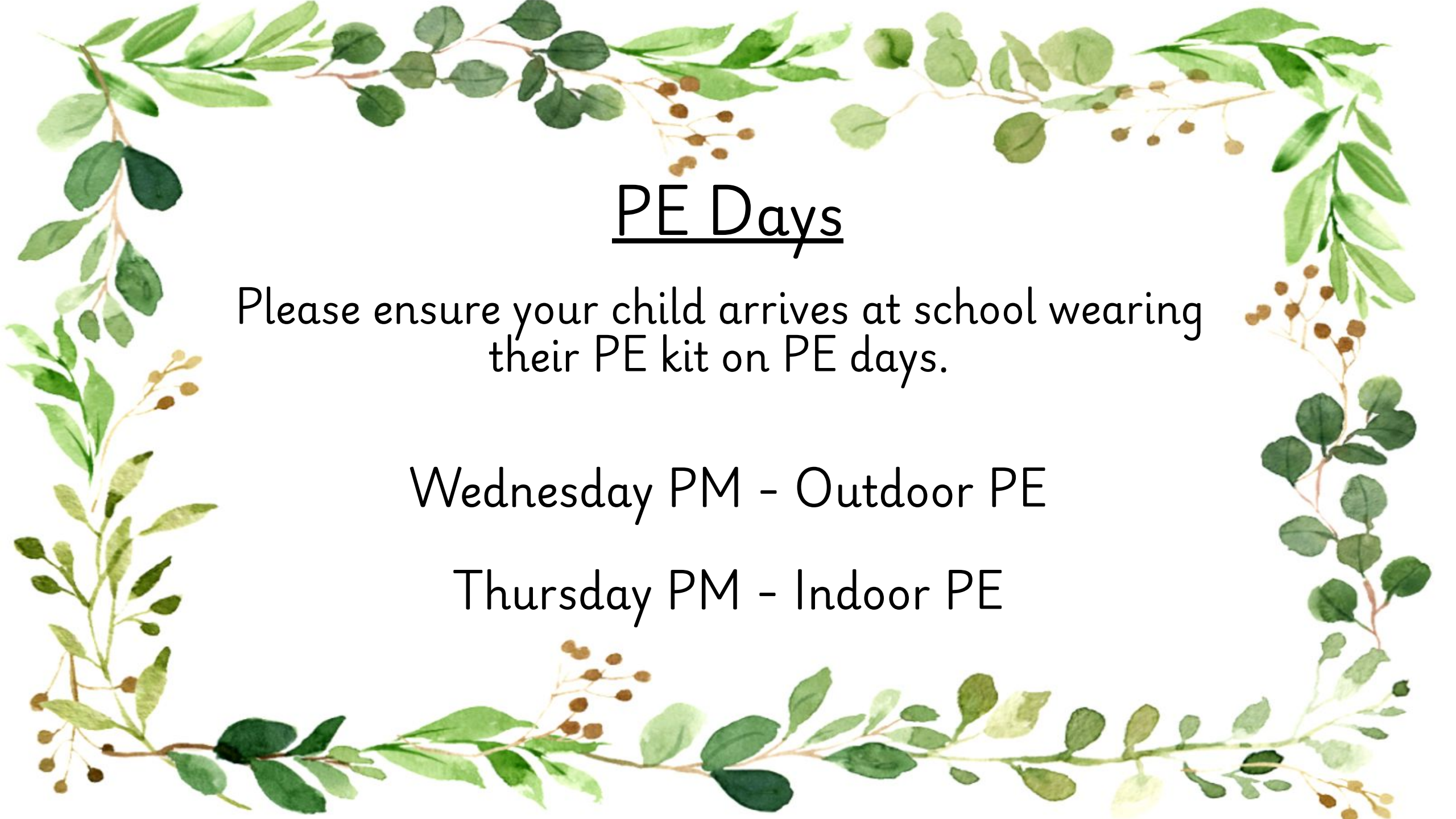


# Continuous Provision

Continuous provision gives children opportunities to learn through a mixture of independent activities, exploration and practical experiences linked to our learning in class.

At the start of each lesson, we will deliver a short, subject-specific input to the whole class. Children will then take turns working with a teacher in a small group to complete a task linked to the lesson, while the other children engage in carefully planned continuous provision activities.

These activities will reinforce and practise the skills and knowledge being taught, while encouraging children to develop their independence and confidence. Throughout the week, children will have opportunities to revisit and apply their learning in different ways.
