Identify that most living things live in habitats to which they are suited. Describe how different habitats provide for the basic needs of different kinds of animals and plants, and how they depend on each other. Identify and name a variety of plants and animals in their habitats, including micro-habitats. Describe how animals obtain their food from plants and other animals. Understand a simple food chain, and identify and name different sources of food. 			<u>Art - Drawing</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Know how to draw with an extensive variety of drawing tools. Know that a sketchbook is where ideas can be collected and drawings can be planned and practiced at various scales. Know how to draw for a sustained period from real objects, using a viewfinder to look closely at an area of interest before drawing. Know how to use of the visual elements – line, shape, pattern and colour – in their drawing. Know how to layer different medias - felt tips over pastels, ballpoint over charcoal.
