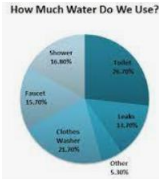
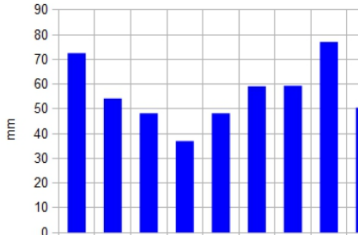
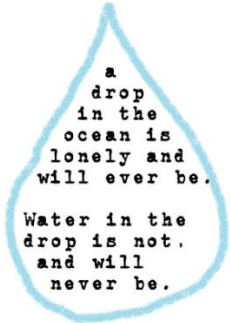


Year 4: A Drop in the Ocean Homework

Draw or paint a picture of a seascape or under sea scene. 	Create a collage using recycled materials. 	Design and make a model boat/ship/raft or other boat you might find in the sea, on a river or in a canal 
Keep a record of all the water you use during a week- toilet flushes, showers, drinking, washing clothes and pots. 	Investigate this question: What happens to freezing point of water when you add salt? Can you test any other materials that might have the same/opposite effect?	Create your own water cycle in a sandwich bag or a glass jar. 
Measure the rainfall this half term and present your results in a graph or table. (see instructions on Met Office website) 	Write a poem based on water (sea, river, canal, water creatures, boats). 	Make a comic strip version of the water cycle. A water drop could be your main character!
