Learning new vocabulary from different countries. Share experiences, thoughts and feelings.

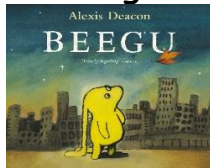

Develop confidence in the local community- bus journey

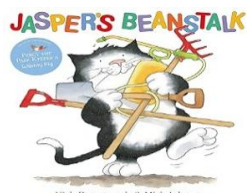
