## *‘Let Your Light Shine’*

*Matthew 5:16*

Can you believe we’re already in February? There are now only two weeks left until the end of this half term.

Mrs Marsden is currently setting up the appointments for this term’s Parents’ Evenings, which will go live later this week. This term, appointments will take place across two dates - one before half term and one after. It is really important that you attend. The partnership between school and home is vital, and working together ensures we can best support your child. Parents’ Evening gives us the opportunity to discuss how your child is getting on, celebrate their successes, and agree on the next steps.

For parents who are separated, we ask that you either attend together or take turns. Unfortunately, we cannot offer two separate appointments unless there is a court order in place.

Next Wednesday, we will begin helping the children explore the season of Lent. Lent is an important time in the Christian calendar, and we want to support the children in understanding its themes in a way that feels meaningful and age-appropriate. To do this, we’ll be setting up a series of interactive stations that invite the children to pause, reflect, and take part in simple hands-on activities.

Each station will focus on a different idea connected to Lent, including:

- **Lengthening** – Preparing for Easter and thinking about how Christians try to live well
- **Letting Go** – The traditions of Shrove Tuesday and the idea of giving things up
- **Life Choices** – The meaning of Ash Wednesday
- **Listening** – Taking time to be still and notice God during Lent
- **Following** – Understanding temptation and making thoughtful choices
- **Keeping Going** – Seeing Lent as part of a lifelong journey of faith


These engaging experiences will help the children reflect on the different themes and deepen their understanding of Lent in a gentle, thoughtful way.
