We are delighted to announce that Badgers' residential visit will take place at Robinwood Activity Centre from 14th July to 16th July 2027.

Residential visits provide fantastic opportunities for children to learn outside the classroom, take on new challenges and develop important life skills. During their stay, pupils will build confidence, independence, resilience and teamwork through a wide range of exciting activities. Fully trained and qualified Robinwood instructors, supported by school staff, will lead a varied programme of activities in a safe, secure and well-supervised environment.

Robinwood is renowned for providing memorable outdoor learning experiences, and we are confident that this residential will be a highlight of your child's primary school journey. Throughout the visit, children will enjoy a range of adventurous activities while creating lasting memories with their friends.

Cost and Payment Information

The total cost of the residential is £359.10:

- Robinwood Activity Centre: £335.00
- Coach Travel: £24.10

We require consent and a deposit of £90 (non-refundable) per pupil by 30th September 2026 with the outstanding balance of £269.10 paid by 30th June 2027.

To help families spread the cost, the remaining balance has been divided into nine monthly payments of £29.90. Our School Money system allows you to make payments gradually throughout the year or pay in larger amounts whenever convenient.

PTA Support

In previous years, our PTA has very generously helped to fund coach travel for residential visits. This year, due to lower fundraising income and fewer opportunities to raise funds, they are unfortunately unable to contribute towards the transport costs.

We would like to take this opportunity to thank the PTA for their continued support of our school and the many events, resources and experiences they provide for our children throughout the year. Their commitment to enriching school life is greatly valued and appreciated.

Financial Support

We understand that many families are facing financial pressures at the moment. As a school, we may be able to access charitable funding to support families who would otherwise struggle with the cost of the residential.

Please do not hesitate to speak to us if you have any concerns. All enquiries will be treated sensitively and confidentially. Applications for financial assistance should need to be submitted by 30th September 2026. If support is agreed, we will agree an appropriate payment schedule with you.
