Select one task from the table below for each half term. You will need to complete two in total. Don't forget we expect the same high-quality research, thought and care with presentation, as we do in school.

Create a wireless radio script. Think about 1940s culture, music and appropriate topics.	Create a fact file about a relative or family friend who was alive during World War II.	Create some top trump cards linked to World War II.
In World War II food was rationed. Find a war time recipe for you to make. Don't forget to take a photo or bring some in for us to taste!	Imagine what it would have been like to be evacuated during World War II. Write a diary which contains at least 5 different entries.	Create a World War II masterpiece.
As clothes were rationed everyone needed to make do and mend. Try repairing a sock which has a hole in it. There are some really useful videos on YouTube.	Make a model of a German or British war vehicle from the 2nd World War. Think about colour, design, materials and structure. You could make a model plane, a U Boat or a landing craft.	Create your own playable WW2 themed board game. Make sure you write some instructions so that people understand how to play and how to win. Think about the counters, question cards and obstacles that you might include.
One of the slogans for World War II was 'Dig for Victory'. Grow your own winter vegetables.	A letter home – Pretend you are a soldier and write a letter to family back home.	Free choice! Research and present something related to World War II which particularly interests you.
