


A warm welcome back to a new school year!



Homework

Seesaw will be the place to find homework activities. Two activities will be set on Thursday. One will be Maths based and the second will vary.

The children will also receive weekly spellings to learn at home. A booklet will be sent with activities to help them learn these spellings. The children will have a spelling check on a Friday.

Read, Write Inc books will be sent home when the children have shared them in their group, along with a second book that uses the same sounds in a new adventure. Please return both Read, Write Inc. books on Mondays.

Story basket books will be changed every Monday and Friday. These books are designed to be shared with an adult and allow the children to enjoy hearing a story read to them.

Remember...

PE will take place on Mondays and Thursdays. Year 1 children will need to keep their PE kit at school. Due to school health and safety rules, long hair should be tied back and earrings should be taken out or covered with micropore before arriving at school. Children should wear suitable footwear with fastenings they can manage themselves. They are also welcome to wear joggers or tracksuits as some of our lessons may take place outdoors. These should be school colours where possible.

Children need to bring fresh water, in a labelled bottle, every day. A healthy snack can be sent in for play time and a piece of fruit will be provided, by school, for afternoon fruit break.
