- **Imaginative & Role Play:** Dressing-up clothes, old suitcases, fabric/tarps, kitchen utensils, and steering wheels.
- **Sensory & Exploration:** Sand, mud kitchen materials, pebbles, shells, and pine cones.
- **Active & Movement:** Skipping ropes, small bikes/scooters, traffic cones, and large crates.

Thank you so much for all your lovely messages on Seesaw and for your continued support of the Pre-school and the School. We can't wait to build on this year's success next year.

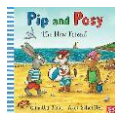
Spare uniform
