Phonics & Reading – Little Wandle

The phonics scheme we follow in school is called **Little Wandle Letters** and **Sounds** which the children followed last year.

Phonics is taught every day – whole class – during the autumn term.
We also learn the Year 2 spelling rules which are taught separately.

Reading – Little Wandle

All children will read as part of a guided reading group three times per week (beginning 18th September 2023)

Books to be sent home:

- Reading Practice Books
- O Sharing books 2 Reading for Pleasure books
- Books will be changed and sent home each Thursday. The expectation is that children read for a minimum of 10 minutes each day).
- Re-reading a book is excellent for developing comprehension and fluency.

Please send reading folders into school every day.

School Library

The children are encouraged to read for pleasure and each class visits the school library weekly.

- OClass 2a Fridays

Spelling

Year 2 spelling rules will be taught each week using the Spelling Shed scheme.

Further information about how you can access Spelling Shed at home will be sent later in the term.

Feedback

We are eager to ensure that feedback for work completed is as effective as possible.

- Written feedback will be used where it is appropriate;
- O Some feedback will be verbal (whole class, group or individual);
- This means that there will not always be green pen on every piece of child's work.

E-Safety

Through e-safety, the children are taught about many aspects:

- Staying safe online
- Digital trails
- Cyber bullying
- Effective internet searching using key words
- Evaluating and choosing websites they like

What homework can we expect in Year 2?

- O For homework, we will be continuing with our 'Homework Menu' where the children choose at least one piece of homework to complete each half term; however, they can complete as many as they want! There will be a date when the homework is due in then the children will share it with their class. We would like to encourage all work to be emailed in where possible, but it can be brought in.
- We encourage you to read at home with your child daily.
- TTRockstars (times tables) The children will receive login details for this from January. By the end of Year 2, the children need to know their 10x, 2x and 5x tables.

When are our PE Days?

All Year 2 children have **indoor PE every Monday** and **outdoor PE every Thursday**. We will continue to go outside as the weather deteriorates.

Children should wear PE kit on PE days. PE kits are as follows:

- O Plain t-shirt in their house colour or plain white (with or without school logo)
- Navy or black plain shorts/skort, plain dark leggings or jogging bottoms (to wear over shorts if the weather is cold)
- Plain black trainers preferably with Velcro fastening for younger children (unless they can tie their own laces)
- School royal blue sweatshirt (plus a plain blue/grey/black hoodie to go over the top during cold weather – no slogan/logo)

Coats

O Please ensure your child has a coat **every** day – we do go out even if it is raining. Often it can rain on a day where it looks like it may not, so please send your child with a coat of some description each day.

Rewards

- Proud Cloud linked to the school rules. When we spot children who make us proud, their peg moves onto the proud cloud.
- Cube jar Cubes are given to the whole class when they are working together positively as a class. Counters can also be collected for individual achievements. When the counter jar is full, the counters can be exchanged for a cube.
- VIP One child is chosen at random; they have special jobs to do in the classroom, have a special place to sit and they can line up at the front of the line as well as a number of other things.

Snacks & Water Bottles

- O Toast is available daily from the 18th September for 25p a slice. Please pay using ParentPay.
- Fruit is available daily;
- The children may bring in a healthy snack from home, but please be aware that there are children in school with severe milk allergies and nut allergies - we are a nut-free school.
- O Children are encouraged to drink water regularly. Please ensure that water bottles have a sports cap, not a screw top as these often spill. No Chilly's bottles please.

- O Autumn term parents' evening will be virtual on Wednesday 18th and Thursday 19th October.
- The spring term parents' evening will be face to face on Tuesday 27th and Thursday 29th February.

SATS

SATs are no longer statutory for Year 2 children. However, the government are publishing formal guidance on schools accessing end of Key Stage 1 assessments later in the autumn term.
