

#### **PFTA News**

PFTA/School meeting (9 - 10am, school) Join in discussions with the PFTA and school representatives about future events and fundraising requests from the school.

Autumn PFTA Disco - Thursday 16th Oct. Years 1-6 after school event. Reception classes get their own in school hours disco as a gentle introduction to school discos. More details to follow! Volunteers for the events will be needed.

Uniform shop - Volunteers are needed to open the pre-loved uniform shop 2:45-3:10 on Fridays. This is a valuable resource for our school community so a fab way to help your school. Volunteers don't need to be available every Friday, just need a group of helpers to rotate in. Guidance will be provided and 2 parents needed to help each week.

#### Courteous Parking

The parking enforcement officers have been monitoring parking around school and will be continuing to do so. Please ensure that you park legally in a side road with consideration for our neighbours and other road users. Please note that there should be no parking in the layby outside school.

# Safety reminder

To ensure your child's safety, please remember the following government regulations:-

Children must <u>normally use a child car seat</u> until they're 12 years old or 135 centimetres tall, whichever comes first.

Children over 12 or more than 135cm tall must wear a seat belt.

You can choose a child car seat based on your child's height or weight.

### School Attendance, including Persistent Absences and Holidays during Term Time

The government has a persistence absence threshold of 10%. The absence threshold of 10% means that if a pupil is absent for 38 sessions (19 days) of school, they are classified as persistently absent. Schools are urged to inform parents of this threshold and to advise parents that fines will be made for persistent absence, unless there is evidence of a justifiable reason for such absence, for example, significant illness. Failure to make payment will result in legal action for failure to ensure regular attendance at school under Section 444 (1) Education Act 1996.

As you are aware, we are not allowed to grant any leave of absence during term time, unless there are exceptional circumstances. An exceptional circumstance is usually a one-off, unique situation that is of significant emotional, educational or spiritual value which outweighs the loss of teaching time. It is our duty to strongly urge parents or carers to avoid booking holidays, appointments or visits overseas during term-time. In addition, it is important that we advise you that under the legislation there is an expectation that schools will issue a Fixed Penalty Notice to those parents who take their children on an unauthorised leave of absence (holiday) in term time.

# Penalty Notices will be issued for Term time leave: Penalty Notice fines will be issued for term time leave of 5 or more consecutive days Unauthorised absence: A Penalty Notices may be considered when there have been 10 sessions of unauthorised absences in a 10 week period. Per Parent/Per Child Penalty Notice fines will continue to be issued per parent per child. For example: 3 siblings absent for term time leave, would result in each parent receiving 3 separate fines. The first time a Penalty Notice is issued for term time leave or unauthorised school attendance the fine £160 per parent, per child if paid within 28 days of the issue, reducing to £80 per parent, per child if paid within 21 days. (Unpaid penalty notices may result in a parental prosecution) Second Offence Where it is deemed appropriate to issue a second penalty notice to the same parent for the same pupil within 3 years of the first penalty notice, for either term time leave or unauthorised attendance the second penalty notice will be charged at: £160 if paid within 28 days. (Unpaid penalty notices may result in a parental prosecution) Third Offence On the third time that an offence is committed within 3 years of the first penalty notice for either a term time leave or irregular attendance, a penalty notice will not be issued. The case may proceed to Parental Prosecution under the Single Justice Procedure. If found guilty of the offence of 'Failure to send a child to school' the Magistrates can impose a fine up to £1000.
