This Sunday, we will begin Advent, a very special time in the Church when we prepare to celebrate the birth of Jesus at Christmas. Advent is a season of hope, peace, joy, and love, helping us remember the true meaning of Christmas.

During Advent, we will be reflecting on God's promises and the true meaning of Christmas, learning how we can grow closer to Jesus in our thoughts, words, and actions. We will have an Advent wreath with four candles, each representing one of the four weeks of Advent, to help focus on the spiritual themes of the season.

First Week of Advent - Hope

The first week of Advent is about hope. During the first week of Advent, the children will be learning about the importance of waiting and trusting in God's promises. The first candle, called the "Prophecy Candle" or "Hope Candle," reminds us that hope helps us stay strong and patient, even when we are waiting for something important.
