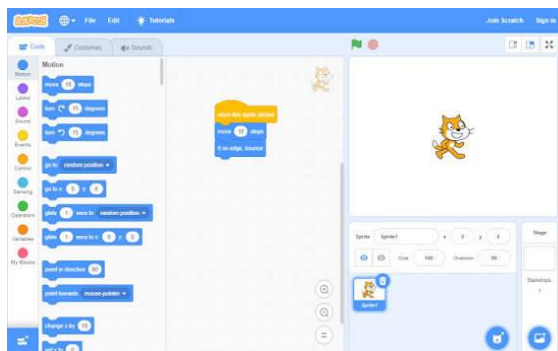


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YEAR 1

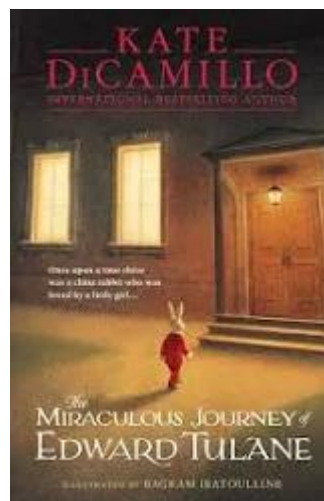
I really like TTRockstars and I have improved a lot since I first got it because I normally practice!

We go to swimming in a pair of two to Move. We do 2 weeks of water safety we go with our pyjamas for those two weeks.

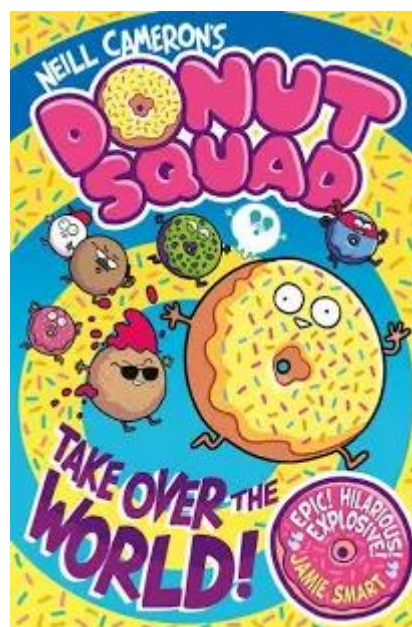
Our most exciting Science lesson was when we put 5 eggs in different cups with different liquids.
