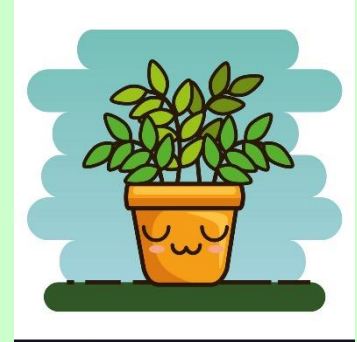

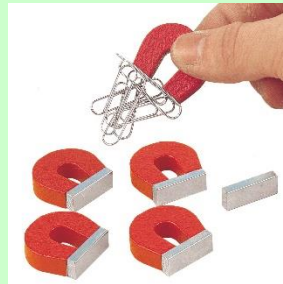

Maths No Problem

Continuing with Maths No Problem this year

- Gives children a context to bring the lessons to life.
- Focus on methods rather than answer. Develops children's mathematical thinking.
- Children will use a combination of maths journals, Maths No Problem workbooks and textbooks.
- Extra challenges will be provided when children have tackled the problems and mastered the skills.

Reading is the 'corner stone' of every single lesson!

Reading at School

Class book read to the children by the teacher and teaching assistants.

Children will receive engaging reading lessons every week, where they will develop many reading skills such as retrieval, inference and predictions.

Reading at Home



All children will take a Big Cat book and a book from their class library home.

Children are expected to read with an adult and independently 5 times weekly for 15 minutes.

Please sign in their reading records with:

Once a week, children to write a comment about their reading and explore the interesting vocabulary.

PE



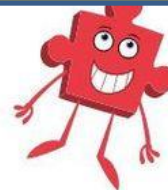
- This year, Year 3 will have PE on most Wednesdays and every Thursday. These days are subject to change due to staff CPD & subject leadership schedule.

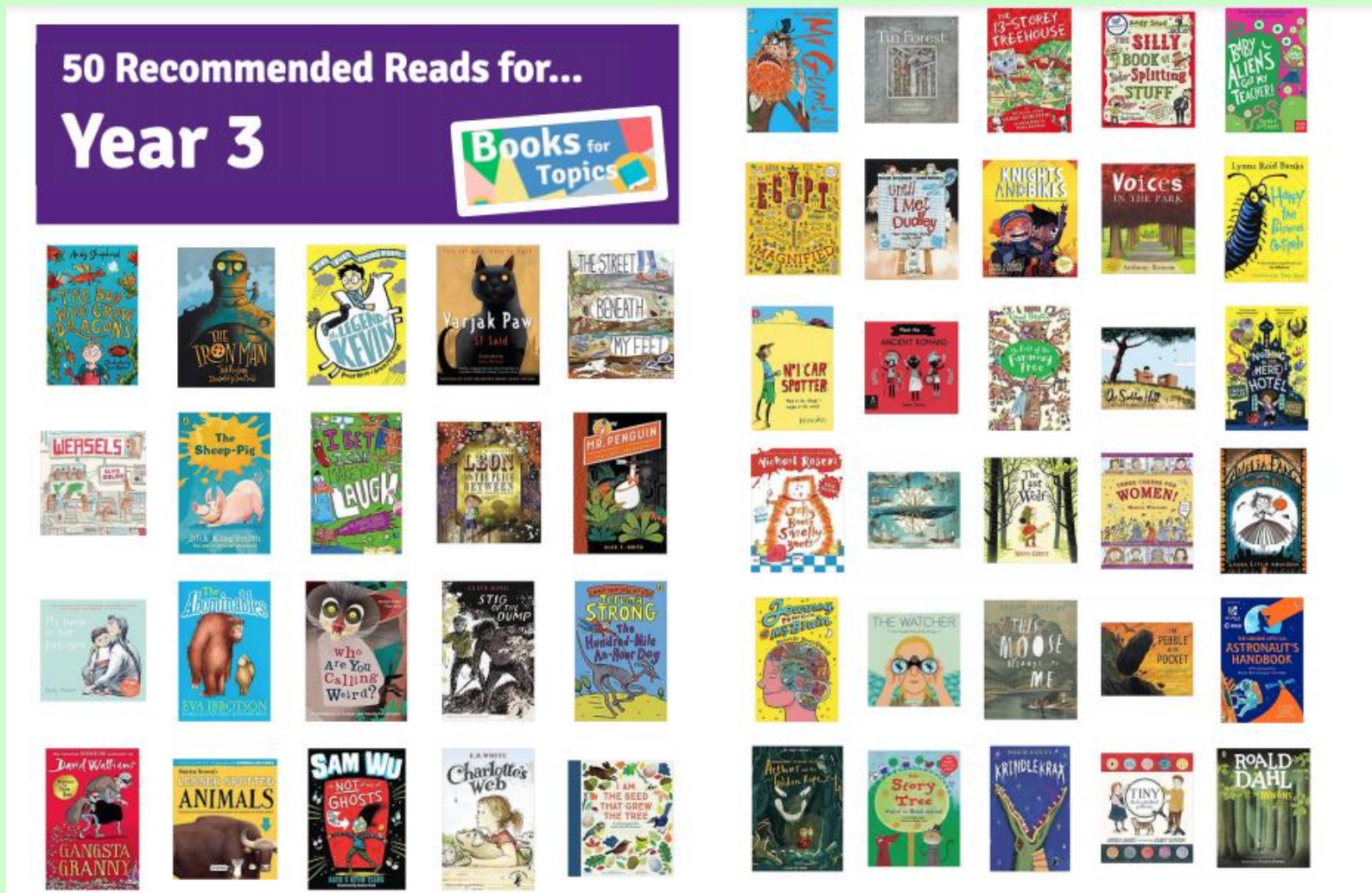
