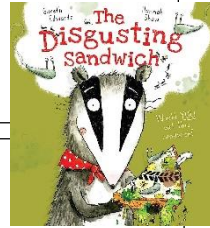
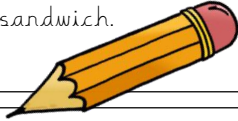


FIGHTING FIT CURRICULUM MAP AUTUMN 1

English

In English, the children are going to begin by writing a product description of a disgusting sandwich using adjectives. They will then re-tell the opening to the story 'The Disgusting Sandwich'. They will use role play and sentence sequencing to plan their ideas before writing. They will also write a set of instructions linked to their DT project where they inform a reader on how to make a delicious sandwich.



Maths

This half term the children will be learning to:

- Count in steps of 2, 3, and 5 from 0, and in tens from any number, forward and backwards
- Recognise the place value of each digit in a two-digit number
- Identify, represent and estimate numbers using different representations, including the number line
- Compare and order numbers from 0 up to 100 using $<$, $>$ & $=$ signs
- Read and write numbers to at least 100 in numerals and in words
- Use place value and number facts to solve problems.

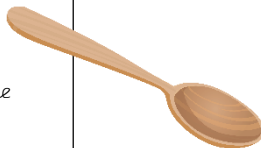

Design & Technology

The focus of the children's design & technology project this half term is **food technology**. The children will begin by exploring where food comes from and be able to sort foods into the 5 main food groups. They will then learn about some common snacks of their continent Australasia. The children will draw a mock-up design of an Australian cake and label the ingredients and equipment they will need to bake the recipe. Towards the end of the unit the children will follow a simple recipe and create a lamington cake to enjoy with friends.

Science

This half term the children will be learning to:

- Notice that animals, including humans, have offspring which grow into adults
- Find out about and describe the basic needs of animals, including humans, for survival (water, food and air)
- Describe the importance for humans of exercise, eating the right amounts of different types of food, and hygiene.



Music

The children are going to explore the skills of finding the pulse and pitch in different songs this half term. They will practice identifying high and low pitches and clapping out the pulse in a familiar song. They will also work in groups to compose their own piece using crochets and quavers.

P.E.

The children's P.E. sessions will be on a:

Monday and Friday afternoon.

The focus of children's P.E. unit this half term is: **Invasion Games.**



Geography

The children will be re-capping their knowledge from Year 1 by naming and locating the worlds continents and oceans using atlases to support them. They will identify where they are in the world and explore the human and physical features of each continent.

RE

The children are going to learn about Christianity for their first half term. They will be exploring the main features of a church, the types of worship that happens there and why churches are so important to Christians.

Computing

This half term the children's computing unit will be: **Coding**

- Understand what algorithms are; how they are implemented as programs on digital devices; and understand that programs execute by following precise and unambiguous instructions
- Create and debug simple programs
- Use logical reasoning to predict the behaviour of simple programs
