- Spelling (from Spring 2 Year 2 onwards)
 - o Y2 (from Spring 2): 3 times per week
 - o y3: 3 times per week
- Maths
 - YI: Numbots 3 times per week
 - Y2 onwards: Times Tables Rock Stars 3 times per week

Little and often is best - short, regular practice of 5-10 minutes makes the most difference.
