# Key Information

## Forest School

- This term, Forest School will take place on Thursday.

## PE

- PE is on: Monday and Wednesday. Please ensure children come to school in full PE kit on these days.

## Homework

- Reading - at least 3 times per week
- Phonics (Early Years & KS1)
  - Y1: Phonics and Teach Your Monster to Read - 3 times per week
  - Y2 (Autumn & Spring 1): Phonics practice as appropriate
- Spelling (from Spring 2 Year 2 onwards)
  - Y2 (from Spring 2): 3 times per week
  - Y3: 3 times per week
- Maths
  - Y1: Numbots - 3 times per week
  - Y2 onwards: Times Tables Rock Stars - 3 times per week

Little and often is best - short, regular practice of 5-10 minutes makes the most difference.
