
Year 5 Homework Guidance

Homework is set on a Thursday to be returned the following Tuesday. Homework will be posted on the Year 5 class page on our website for you to access.



Reading

As much as possible, try to read every day. Please record reading in your child's reading diary. Reading diaries will be checked regularly and team points will be awarded for regular reading. We can't stress the importance of reading enough.

Spelling

An overview of the current term's spellings is available on the class page of the website. Each week, a spelling list will be sent home for your child to learn. There are suggestions of activities you may wish to complete in your child's homework book.

A dictation activity will be completed on a Tuesday to monitor spelling progress. This is recorded in the back of homework books.

<u>Maths</u>

An activity will be sent home for completion that consolidates learning in the classroom. Times Tables should continue to be practised regularly (I recommend using TTRockstars). Awards are still available in class and assemblies for effort and achievement.

Presentation

Please encourage your child to take pride in their homework and present work neatly. Pencils should be used for Maths and biro pens can be used for any writing. Please avoid using felt tip pens in books. It is helpful is work is dated.

<u>Support</u>

Please take time, where possible, to support your child with their homework as the benefits do not go unnoticed in class. Little and often tends to be better when completing homework activities. Please encourage children to hand their homework in on time. If homework is not handed in on time, it may not be marked at a later date. If your child has found homework challenging, please do drop me a note in their homework book so we can address this in class.
