<p>1. ABC Order</p> <p>Write all of your spelling words in alphabetical order.</p> 	<p>2. Word Parts</p> <p>Use a coloured pencil to divide the words into syllables. eg. <b>environment</b></p>	<p>3. Other Handed</p> <p>Write each word 5 times, switching the hand you write with each.</p>	<p>4. Vowel Spotlight</p> <p>Write your words using one colour for the vowels and another colour for the consonants. <b>(vowels: a, e, i, o, u)</b></p>
<p>5. Pyramid Words</p> <p>r rh rhy rhyth rhyth rhythm</p>	<p>6. Ransom Words</p> <p>"Write" your words by cutting letters out of a magazine or newspaper and glue them to spell your words.</p>	<p>7. Rainbow Words</p> <p>Write your spelling words with coloured pencils. Make each letter a different colour.</p>	<p>8. Scrambled Words</p> <p>Ask another person to scramble each word up. Can you unscramble them? <b>eg. cayht = yacht</b></p>

Prefixes and Suffixes</p> <p>Underline the prefixes and suffixes in the words you are learning. <b>eg. <u>admitt</u>ing</b></p>	<p>11. Word Search</p> <p>Create your own word search with your spellings. Show the answers to your puzzle in a different colour.</p>	<p>12. Pictures</p> <p>Draw a picture for each of your spellings.</p> 
<p>13. Words Without Vowels</p> <p>Write each word replacing the vowels with a line. Go back and see if you can fill in the vowels. <b>eg. q-st-n - question</b></p>	<p>14. Train Words</p> <p>Write the entire list end to end as one long word. Write each new word in a different colour. <b>eg. languagefiniteachieve</b></p>	<p>15. Bubble Writing</p> <p>Write your spellings out in bubble writing.</p> 	<p>16. Words Within Words</p> <p>Write each spelling word and find as many words as you can within that word. <b>eg. catch = cat, hat</b></p>
<p>17. Picture Words</p> <p>Draw a picture and hide your spelling words in the picture.</p>	<p>18. Code Words</p> <p>Create a code for each letter of the alphabet and then write each word in code. <b>eg. a = ▲ b = ● c = ★</b></p>	<p>19. Backwards Words</p> <p>Write your spelling words forwards and then backwards.</p>	<p>20.
