Reading diary

- Reading diaries in book bags every day
- The books have no words in!!!
- Wordless books often promote more discussion than books with words, which leads to better comprehension. We tend to focus on, and appreciate, the details in the pictures more in these types of books. They also encourage the introduction of new vocabulary, help develop storytelling skills and present many opportunities to practice writing.
- For *pre-readers*, wordless books give them the opportunity to actually read and understand a book all by themselves.

Physical Development

- P.E will be on a Monday and Thursday
- Please can the children come dressed in their PE kit.
 Weather can be very variable so dress appropriately in tracksuit bottoms.
- Keep practising putting a coat/jumper on, especially when they have pulled the arms inside out.

- Ear-rings




Baseline assessment
