## Year 6—Performance of Snap Trap—Safety Online

On Wednesday 22<sup>nd</sup> April Year 6 visited Cuddington Primary School with the other year 6 classes from the Trust. We watched a drama production called Snap Trap which taught us how to stay safe online using the SMART rules. We learnt that S for safe, M for meeting, A for accepting, R for reliable and T for tell. At snap trap they recreated 2 true stories about 2 children who fell into the "snap trap" by making wrong decisions online.

This first story was about a girl called Amy who downloaded apps she was too young for; therefore, she didn't follow SMART rules. Sadly, this led to Amy talking online to people she didn't know and meeting up with a person she didn't expect. The story didn't end well for Amy.

On the other hand, in the 2<sup>nd</sup> story a boy named Sam was forced by a school bully to make several bad decisions. In Sam's story the dates become worse and more dangerous each time. Sam was peer pressured as he felt that if he didn't follow what she asked him to do she would tell the teachers and Sam would get into even more trouble.

At the end of the production, we learnt to always tell trusted adults if you have done something bad online by following the SMART rules. The performance was amazing in teaching us not to fall into the snap trap!
