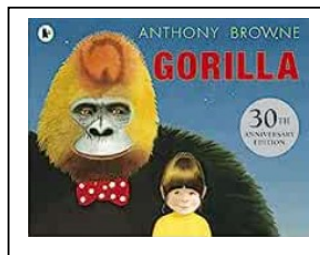
Welcome back everybody!

Topic Work

Our topic work this term will focus on discovering life during the Egyptian times. We will explore who the Egyptians were, how they lived and how they impacted our lives today.



Literacy

- We will be thinking about the power of imagery in poetry and writing our own poems.

Maths

- Place value – discovering 3 and 4 digit numbers.
- Addition and subtraction – developing our mental and written strategies.
- Shape- exploring and categorising 2D shapes.

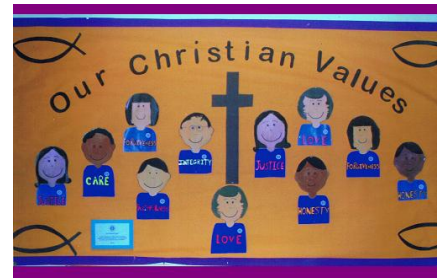
