Thankfulness

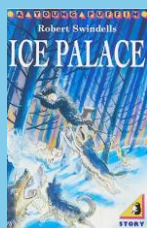
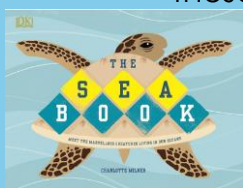

Maths

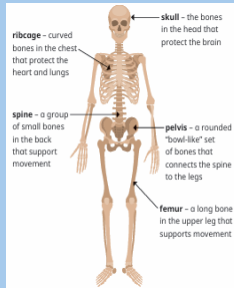
Place value, addition and subtraction, area, length and perimeter.

Our history work this term will focus on discovering life during the Stone Age. We will explore the question 'What do humans need to survive?' and how the stone age people conquered these challenges.

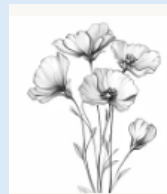

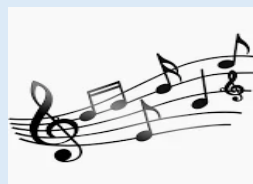
