Reporting Absence and lateness.

If your child is running late please also choose option 1 and leave your child's full name and teacher.

Please make sure you use the absence line and not email to report absences as emails are not constantly monitored.

Appointments during the school day

If your child has an appointment during the school day, school will request to see confirmation of the appointment in the form of a letter, text, card etc.

If you are collecting your child for any other circumstances, we request that they are collected between 12 and 1pm so as not to disrupt lessons. An absence request form must also be completed prior to the date. The forms can be found on the school website under the school information tab.
