Mathematics


We will learn about:

Religious Education


We will be answering the big question: What makes people special?

We will be:

Physical Development

Physical activity is vital in children's all-round development, enabling them to pursue happy, healthy and active lives.

Children will have opportunities to develop their gross motor skills every day in the Reception outdoor area and PE lessons once a week.

Fine motor skills are developed through a range of activities.

We will learn:

- How to work as a team
- How to share equipment and take turns
- How to dodge safely
- How to play fairly and accept decisions in games
