As Writers, we will....

The children will immerse themselves in the text, the settings, characters and rich vocabulary, to enable them to produce two quality written outcomes: a newspaper report and a setting narrative.

We will learn to.....

- use the correct punctuation in direct and indirect speech
- vary sentence structure to give detail and to provide impact
- use expanded noun phrases, fronted adverbials and subordination to draw in the reader and add detail
- use sentences with prefixes and suffixes
- use prepositions to show position and time



As Readers, we will....

- read our class book, The Boy at the Back of the Class.
- Make predictions using our background knowledge
- Answer literal questions by highlighting answers in the text
- Build our vocabulary looking at a range of texts including non fiction, fiction and poetry.



As Scientists, we will.....

begin to study teeth and digestion

We will learn to be able to.....

- -describe the simple functions of the basic parts of the digestive system in humans -identify the different types of teeth in humans and animals and link to their simple functions and diet.
- learn about the different organs, what their function is, and locate /identify each organ in an image of the human body.

As Spellers, we will....

- recap our knowledge of prefixes:
- -ful, -less, -ness, -ous, -ture, -ment
- revisit common exception and high frequency words from Y3/4
