

In Mathematics, we will...

- Learn our numbers to 50.
- Learn to use tens and ones to create numbers to 50.
- Practice counting forwards and backwards from 0-50.
- Explore length and height.
- Explore mass and volume.

Use NumBots to help build your child's Maths skills.



In English, we will...

Read our vehicle text "Where the Wild Things are" by Maurice Sendak

The children will explore this beautifully illustrated story and discuss different language features.

The children will:

- Write instructions on 'How to Care for a Wild Thing'
- We will be focusing on:
 - Imperative (bossy) verbs
 - Letter formation
 - Capital letters
- We are focusing on handwriting, ensuring that our letters are formed correctly and are appropriately sized.

Explore high quality texts and poetry.

- Answer questions by finding evidence from the text.
- Make inferences such as inferring characters' feelings, thoughts and motives.

In Science, we will...

- What different animals eat.
- Humans are mammals.
