- **Monday, May 11, 2026:** English Grammar, Punctuation, and Spelling (GPS) papers 1 and 2.
- **Tuesday, May 12, 2026:** English Reading paper.
- **Wednesday, May 13, 2026:** Mathematics papers 1 (arithmetic) and 2 (reasoning).
- **Thursday, May 14, 2026:** Mathematics paper 3 (reasoning).
