


Helping your child with spelling

To support children with their spelling homework, we have created this strategy booklet. The strategies are designed to make the practice of spellings engaging and varied, as well as supporting retention and recall of spelling patterns and sounds.

Strategy One

Squiggle

Draw a squiggle on a page. Use different coloured pens or pencils to write each word several times in a different area of the squiggle.

Strategy Three


Pyramid

Capital and lower case letters


Write the words in upper case letters and lower case letters.


Highlight

Across and down


Write your words across and down, sharing the same first letter.
