

Session 8 (Literacy): Become a Rugby Scout



WARM UP - YOU WILL NEED...

- Pen and paper
- A simple knowledge of Rugby

MATCH

In this session your child will be researching key information relating to a player or club of their choice. They will then create a poster or fact file about their player or club - let's get creative!

Talk about the different facts that could be included in the 'Fact File'.

Discuss key information with your child e.g **Why is a front row forward heavier than a scrum half? Why is a second row taller than most other players?**

Whilst designing the fact file/poster, your child should develop an understanding of what images could be added to enhance their poster. Images could also represent some of the key statistics and facts.

Your child can do this activity digitally using apps such as PowerPoint, Keynote or Slides

When your child's poster or fact file is complete, ask them to talk about any interesting information they have discovered.
