My grown-ups will bring me to the playground in the mornings and wait there at the end of the day. My grown-up will not walk me to the door.



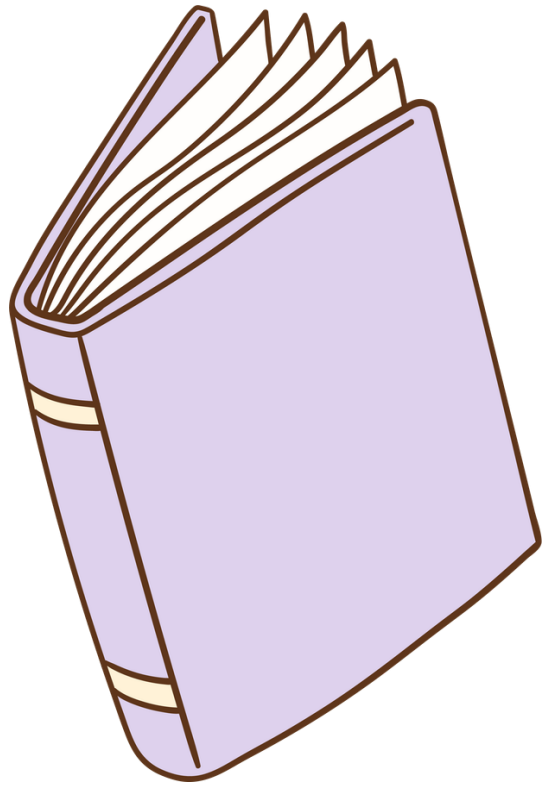

what I am doing each day

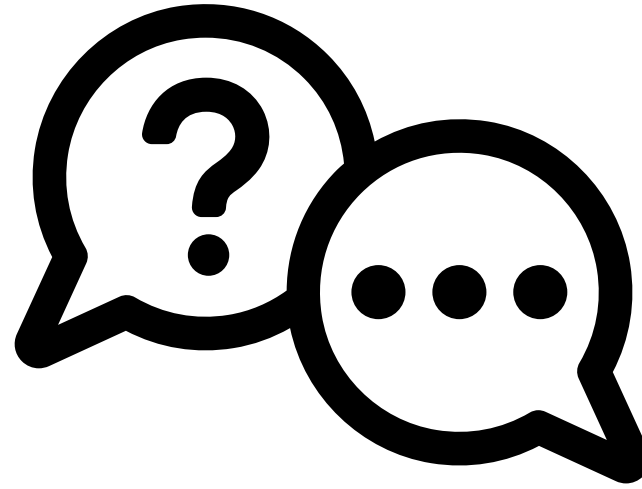
Things that will be different
