# Headteacher's Notes

Dear Parents and Carers,

We were pleased to welcome families to our first Parents to School session of the year hosted by Miss Graham in her reception class. The session provided an opportunity for parents and carers to learn more about the school's approach to early reading and to explore ways to support their child's learning at home. The children thoroughly enjoyed sharing their classroom environment, engaging in activities such as play, creative activities, maths and writing. We hope you enjoyed the session and would like to extend our thanks to all who attended and contributed to the success of the afternoon. Thank you to Miss Graham and the team for such a positive session. Next week, Mrs Williams and Mr Cox will be welcoming parents into school for their sessions – please come along if you can!

This week in my Little People, Big Dreams assembly, I shared the story of Stan Lee who is best known as the creator of hundreds of Marvel superheroes. Beyond his illustrious career, he spent his lifetime championing equality and diversity. Lee knew that what makes humans special is our differences. "I have always included minority characters in my stories, often as heroes," Lee once said. "We live in a diverse society – in fact, a diverse world, and we must learn to live in peace and with respect for each other." The children were inspired by Lee's journey.

Yesterday afternoon, Years 1–5 enjoyed a fantastic assembly led by *Mad Science*, generously funded by *United Utilities*. The session was fun, interactive and educational — helping pupils learn all about how to prevent drain blockages and protect our local environment. The children were fully engaged throughout and had a wonderful time taking part in the experiments and demonstrations. To help them remember their learning, each child also received their very own toilet roll... a fun reminder of the important messages shared during the session!

Year 6 had their second swimming lesson at Queens Park. One group of pupils continued to build their confidence in the water, working hard to develop their kicking strength with the support of noodles and floats. The other group focused on improving their swimming technique, concentrating on effective stroke work and developing their breathing so they can swim longer distances with greater control. All pupils showed fantastic determination and a positive attitude throughout the session. Well Done!
