Headteacher's Notes

Dear Parents and Carers,

Welcome back! I hope you all enjoyed a wonderful half-term break and managed to make the most of the sunshine. It was lovely to hear so many children sharing stories about barbeques, trips to the park and spending time outdoors with family and friends.

As always, we have started the new half-term with a whole-school behaviour reset. This provides an opportunity for all children to revisit our school values – Warm-hearted, Inspire, Never Give Up, Genuine and Strive to Succeed – and to reflect on how these values help us create a positive learning environment for everyone. We have also revisited our expectations for behaviour in the classroom, on the playground and during transitions around the school building.
