Headteacher's Notes

Dear Parents and Carers,

This week has been another busy and exciting one at Robins Lane.

On Monday, we were delighted to welcome Karl Ashton from The Daniel Fox Foundation, alongside Councillor Sharon Roughley, Councillor for Peasley Cross and Fingerpost, Deputy Leader and Portfolio Holder for Safer Communities.

The Daniel Fox Foundation works to raise awareness of knife crime, helping young people to understand the serious and often life-changing consequences that carrying or using a knife can have on individuals, families and communities. Karl delivered a powerful workshop to our Year 6 pupils, focusing on knife crime awareness and prevention. Through open and honest discussions, he encouraged Year 6 to make positive choices, take personal responsibility for their actions and develop strategies to resolve conflict safely. It was inspiring to see Year 6 engage so thoughtfully with such an important topic, leaving them better informed and empowered to make safe decisions in the future. As part of Drowning Prevention Week, Year 3 took part in water safety learning during their swimming lesson. The children were asked to wear a long-sleeved top and long trousers over their swimwear to help them understand how clothing can affect movement in water. In addition, children across the school engaged in a water safety assembly based on information from Merseyside Fire & Rescue Service, helping to reinforce these important life-saving messages.

We have now reached the end of the assessment period for the Phonics Screening Check for children in Years 1 and 2, and the Multiplication Tables Check for children in Year 4. The children have worked incredibly hard and approached these assessments with positive attitudes and determination. We are also grateful to staff for the support and encouragement they have provided throughout the process.

As many of you will know, we invest heavily in the Read Write Inc. programme to support our early readers. This week, we welcomed a Read Write Inc. consultant into school to help us continue to refine and strengthen our provision. The feedback was extremely positive, particularly regarding the quality of teaching and the leadership of early reading. Thank you to Miss Graham and the team of staff who deliver Read Write Inc. every day.

Thank you to all parents and carers who completed our Parent and Carer Survey and Wider School Life Survey. We received 100 responses to the Parent and Carer Survey and 118 responses to the Wider School Life Survey. Your feedback is invaluable and will help leaders continue to develop the school as we prepare for the new academic year and beyond. We have now completed the prize draw and are delighted to announce that Noah C in Preschool was our winner. Congratulations, Noah!

This week, we also shared information about our Summer Reading Reward. We are excited to welcome Ormskirk Beekeepers to school on Monday 6th July. Please check your emails for further information and consent details.

Tomorrow, some of our Year 5 and Year 6 pupils will be representing Robins Lane at the annual Sutton Shield football tournament. We wish the team the very best of luck and hope they continue to demonstrate our WINGS values and strive to succeed.
