This half term we will be looking at number rhymes 1- 3.



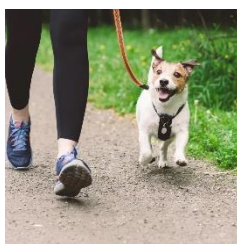
Can you count to 3?

Can you act like the different animals?



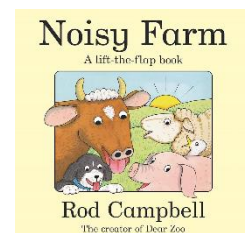
We have been learning the song 'Old Macdonald'... what animals can you think of to sing in the song?
