

Science

In science, we will be:

- Planting a variety of seeds and bulbs and watching them grow
- Finding out about the basic needs of plants for healthy growth
- Learning about the lifecycle of a plant
- Finding out about different plant habitats around the world
- Going on a local walk to find out what plants are growing nearby.

This half term our topic is

‘Let’s Grow.’



In the pots outside the classroom, we will be planting a variety of seeds and bulbs. We are very excited to look after them and watch them grow.

Music

In music we will be:

- Listening to different pieces of music inspired by flowers and composing our own.

Geography

In geography, we will be:

- Finding out about hot and cold countries in relation to the equator and learning about the plants that live there.
- Naming the four countries of the UK and finding out about their national flowers.

Computing

In computing we will be:

- Using an electronic microscope to look at seeds or bulbs
- Using a branching database to identify different seeds and bulbs

Maths

In maths this half term, we are learning to read and write the time to the nearest 5 minutes.

You can support your child by talking about what time you are doing things throughout the day.

Encourage them to use our maths vocabulary:

minute hand, hour hand, o'clock, half past, quarter past, quarter to, five past etc.

We will also look at duration of time. You could talk to your child about how long activities will take e.g. how long a film is or how long it is until tea.

After learning about time, we will be looking at statistics, this means we will learn how to collect and share different types of data. We will find out how to create tally charts, pictograms and block diagrams.
