This half term we will be looking at our senses.



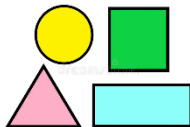
When you are eating your breakfast, lunch or dinner, can you talk about what you can...

Can you practise your throwing and catching?

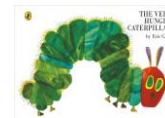


You can support your child's muscle development with playdough, lego, peg activities and threading beads.

Can you crawl like a caterpillar?

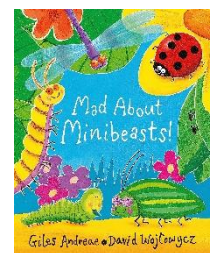


Our favourite stories this half term are...
