

Welcome to Year 3



Year 3 will be taught by Miss Bailey and Miss Farrington.

In the morning, we have daily maths lessons and Read Write Inc. or Literacy. In the afternoons, we will look at a wide variety of topics, such as 'Rocks and Fossils' in science and 'The Stone Age' in history.

Maths

This year, we will look at a variety of maths topics including Place Value, Addition and Subtraction and Multiplication. Children should continue to practise their times tables (2's, 3's, 5's and 10's) as this is an important skill across all areas of mathematics. In Year 3 we will also be learning our 4, 6, 8- and 12-times tables.

There will be TT Rockstar battles against the other classes, please ensure your child takes part as there now is a national year 4 times table assessment online.

Literacy

In literacy, our writing will be inspired by a class book that will support our narrative immersion. This will provide the children with many opportunities to write for a purpose, including stories, letters and diary entries.

Reading

If your child attends RWI sessions in school, they will bring home two RWI books each Thursday to share with you. This book needs to be returned to school each Monday.

If your child attends Literacy sessions, they will bring home an Accelerated Reader book. This will be brought home each evening. Please support them by listening to them read, asking questions about what they have read and recording in their reading diary. These books need to be brought into school every day.

There will be a charge of £2 for lost or damaged books.

Art

Children receive weekly Art sessions on Thursdays led by Mrs Walsh.

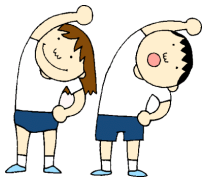


PE

All earrings need to be removed before school or the lesson for PE sessions.
