Spring 2-Learning Menu

This half-term in Year 6 are learning:

English:

Our book focus for this half term is 'The House with Chicken Legs'. We will be writing a letter of persuasion to convince the locals to allow Baba Yaga and Marinka to stay in the town. We will be writing a promotional leaflet for the house with Chicken Legs and a police incident report.

Maths:

Year 6 will be working on decimals. We will be multiplying and dividing decimals by 10, 100 and 100 and other integers using formal methods of multiplication and division. We will be studying fractions as decimals and developing our understanding of how these versions of numerical values both represent parts of whole numbers. Then, we will be studying percentages, including finding percentages of amounts. Algebra will be introduced to the children in a more formal way and finally, Y6 will begin their study of shape and space for this

Geography:

In Geography, we will be revisiting key learning from throughout all year groups. We will be completing retrieval activities based on our 'non-negotiable knowledge'.

Science:

Our topic this half-term is 'The Human Body:

Systems.

We will be learning about the circulatory system and its connection to the respiratory system. We will learn about the make up of our blood, the flow of blood though the heart and how important blood is to the normal function of muscles. We will become experts in our knowledge of the different types of blood ressels and their structure and function.

Religious Education: Our topic this spring term is:
