Suggested Home Study Activities—Phase 3

Below are some suggested home study activities for Year 4, 5 and 6. We don't expect that you complete them all in one go but if you are asked to learn something from your Knowledge Organisers you could complete one of these activities.

<u>Create a quiz</u> Ask a parent or carer to ask you 10 questions about a topic.	<u>Pictionary</u> Draw a picture to show your knowledge.	<u>Mindmap</u> Create a diagram with facts.	<u>Paperchain</u> Make a paper chain with facts written on each chain.
<u>Song/rap</u> Create a song or rap about a topic.	<u>A-Z</u> Think of a word for each letter of the alphabet related to the topic.	<u>Bunting</u> Create bunting with facts on.	<u>Flashcards</u> Write out flashcards and ask someone to quiz you.
<u>Mnemonics</u> Example: My Very Easy Method Just Speeds Up Naming Planets To help remember the planets.	<u>Poster</u> Design an eye-catching poster full of facts.	<u>PowerPoint</u> Make a PowerPoint on a topic.	<u>iMovie</u> Make a short film about a topic.
<u>Record</u> Record yourself saying facts.	<u>Blanks</u> Fill in a paragraph with missing words.	<u>Summary Booklet</u> Make a booklet of facts.	<u>Timeline</u> Make a timeline of a history topic.
<u>Rapidough</u> Make something related to your topic with playdough.	<u>Story</u> Make a story using vital vocabulary.	<u>Wordsearch</u> Make a wordsearch using vital vocabulary/spellings and ask an adult to find them.	<u>Crossword</u> Create clues for vital vocabulary/spellings.
